

## Q&A Regarding Transfers to Bucks County Council, BSA

- Q: Will my BSA ID number change?
- A: No.

Q: When should I link my BSA ID number to BCC?

- A: At this time, this should not be done. We are waiting for instructions from the National Office on how to transfer membership information.
- Q: My unit has completed their internet rechartering. Where should they take their charter?

A: Charters, with payment, may be delivered or mailed to Bucks County Council, BSA at One Scout Way, Doylestown, PA 18901.

Q: Will my Unit ID number change for Internet Advancement and JTE recordings?

- A: No.
- Q: Where can I turn in my advancement reports? Where do I turn in my Eagle Packets?
- A: Advancement reports and Eagle Packets can be turned in Bucks County Council, BSA at the above address. Please be sure to keep a copy for your unit files.
- Q: How does the process work to pick up orders at the Scout Store or Roundtable?
- A: Orders may be emailed to <u>amyhall@bsamail.org</u> or faxed to 215-348-7289. Orders can sent to Roundtable as long as they have been paid for. Rank badges cannot be purchased unless an advancement report has been turned in.
- Q: How does my unit obtain a Certificate of Liability Insurance?
