Typical Infantry Company Camp Layout


(Adapted for Camporee; USE THIS to Guide Your Camp Set-Up)

Senior Staff (Adult Leaders) will form as a single row of tents at the BACK of each company street (shown).

The Company Captain (Sr. Patrol Leader) will occupy a space of his own with his tent about 15 feet down from the line of Sr. Staff tents and 15 feet before the double row of scout "recruit" tents (shown); the Company Captain's tent will also be directly in the CENTER of the company street.

The FIRST scout tent to the left in the DOUBLE ROW of tents will be the tent of the Company First Sergeant (Asst. Sr. Patrol Leader). Diagram shown below explains site layout for <u>all</u> Scout Company sites.

NOTE: Patrol Leaders are the Sergeants; Asst Patrol Leaders are the Corporals; everyone else is a Private. Sgts. and Cpls. should camp at either end of their patrol, to keep their men in good order at all times.
