The South County Park is located in East and West Amwell Townships at the junction of Route 179 and 202. This is about one mile south of the village of Ringoes at the intersection of Route 31 and Route 202. Ringoes is the oldest known settlement in Hunterdon County. The village grew up around John Ringo's Tavern on the Old York Road (now Route 179). The tavern was the site for many meetings of the Hunterdon Chapter of the Sons of Liberty formed in 1766.
